LSO – Call for Comment: Towards More Effective Governance — Governance & Electoral Reforms at the Law Society of Ontario

The LSO's Governance Review Task Force requests input on a foundational set of future changes for a new governance model for the LSO. The changes can significantly impact how and to what extent your association can be represented at the LSO. For more information see the Governance and Electoral Reforms website.

FOLA will be submitting feedback by the LSO's deadline of January 31, 2025.

LSO – Considering Increased Transparency: Licensee Reporting and Disclosure to the Public

The LSO is considering disclosing charges and convictions against lawyers, amongst other things, in its Lawyer and Paralegal Directory. In particular:

• Require that licensees report additional information to the Law Society that is relevant to their practise of law or provision of legal services, including a more comprehensive list of criminal and other charges, findings of guilt, business and trade names, and licensure in other provinces.

• Disclose on the Lawyer and Paralegal Directory some of that information, where it is in the public interest, is relevant to the licensee's professional business and obligations as a licensee, and/or which can be ascertained from other public sources. This includes certain criminal and other charges and findings of guilt and when an investigation is underway, where disclosure is in the public interest.
